Activate the gift card digitally now, otherwise you may be too late! After that, you can spend the gift card on energy-saving items, such as LED lamps, radiator foil, draft strips, energy-saving shower head, etc.

Closing the outside tap

Closing the outside tap in frost periods is very important. This way you prevent a burst water pipe. How do I close the outside tap?

Step 1: Turn off the shut-off valve. This shut-off valve is somewhere between the outside tap and the water meter. In many homes, this shut-off tap is in the well, stair cupboard or under the counter. This shut-off valve also has a small drain valve



Step 2: Turn on the outside tap and the drain valve. As a result, all the water runs out of the pipe and cannot freeze to pieces. If necessary, blow the pipe empty if the water does not flow out by itself.

Step 3: Turn off the drain valve. You can leave the outside tap open. After the frost period, you can open the shut-off tap again and water will come out of the outside tap again.
