

Kicked out of the board....

- Two local residents have come forward who are going to follow a beekeeper course so that they too can safely deal with the bees that are active at the public orchard from the hive placed there.
- At our secretariat we received questions from four social organizations (volunteers from the St. Nicholas Church, the KBO, the Zonnebloem and the Stichting Nieuwe Levenskracht) who all want to do something for long-term sick people based on their own objective. If we already get a picture of them through our network of street contacts, we are not allowed to just pass on the names and addresses and we do not do that. But if you know someone - and that may be throughout the municipality of Valkenswaard, it is not limited to Kerkakkers - who you think belongs to the target group of one or more of the organizations mentioned, first ask that person whether they find it ok that you think that help can be requested and then report it (with the consent of that person) to the organizations mentioned.

Which target groups does who target? The CBE focuses on the elderly (50+).
