Information about solar panels



Energiek Valkenswaard is a working group of nine Valkenswaard citizens who have started a citizens' initiative with the main goal: to provide information about

all the aforementioned aspects of the energy transition. This enthusiastic group of volunteers works closely with and is supported by Kempen Energie and Kempen Stroom from Hapert. There have already been several information evenings.



On 8 November 2023, experts from Kempen Energie will provide all possible information about solar panels. Three companies have also been found willing

to show and explain their possibilities to you. The evening will be held on the initiative of The Kerkakkers Neighbourhood Committee in community centre De Horizon at Amundsenstraat 5, starting at 20:00. All residents are welcome. Admission is **free**, coffee and tea too.

Hey are you planting with us?

It's flower bulb time now. Now planted and in spring color and smell in your garden! In the spring, around February, you already enjoy the first crocuses that stick their heads above the ground. Around March / April the first daffodils and blue grapes. In addition to the fact that flower bulbs brighten up your garden and our neighborhood, the flowers are very important for our insects! They are an important source of pollen and nectar in a period when not much is blooming yet. With the slogan 'Hey are you planning me?' we draw attention to our action. We call on everyone to plant as many bulbs as possible so that the insects have enough food in the spring. Don't have a garden? Then put them in a flower pot on the balcony. Beekeepers and orchard De Rijt

Last year, two local residents started training as beekeepers. In the context of the biodiversity in our district, we are very happy with this. In consultation with the municipality, a number of volunteers have placed a shelter in our public orchard on the Le Sage ten Broekstraat. Under that roof there is room for some beehives. We thank: Frits Hendriks. Cor Meulendijks, Jan Vercammen, Jan Gijsbers and Wil van Hoppe. We are still looking for volunteers who want to help plant and maintain more gestation plants for the bees in the public orchard. Something for you? The district committee would like to hear from you, you are free to work in consultation as you see fit. Both beekeepers successfully completed the training in September, Frank Gelten and Ankie Slaats are now certified beekeepers. They are supported by beekeeper Frans Claassen from Dommelen who has his hives on the Sint Adrianus valley and by the Beekeepers Association.

Sedum roof instead of roof tiles

As you will have seen, a large-scale renovation of, especially roofs, is going on in our neighborhood by Woningbelang.



The block, which starts at Mgr. Poelsstraat 7, has been designated by the building association as a test object for the installation of "green" roofs. Sedum was chosen on top of the insulation of a thick sheet of PUR foam, instead of ordinary roof tiles. These are various types of very strong succulents and it insulates excellently. Good idea for the biodiversity in our neighborhood!

Artwork on display again

In our newsletter of March 2018, we already devoted an article to the artwork at the former primary school Het Kompas, which threatened to disappear if the building was demolished to make way for new construction.



This monumental relief art by Hugo Brouwer was purchased by the municipality in 1970 for approximately 10,000 guilders. Explorers have given their names to the surrounding streets, on the south side of the Dommelseweg. The compass is indispensable for these world travelers. This work of art therefore belongs to the district and is iconic. Efforts should be made to preserve this work in its present location. At the time, a meeting was organized with the municipality to discuss how this work of art can be preserved for our neighborhood. The district committee is supported in this by the city council, which in February 2018 adopted a motion "Strange to the order of the day" to preserve the artwork Het Kompas by Hugo Brouwer: "To do everything possible to save the artwork from the demolition of the building and to bring it back as an icon in the new plans to be developed at this location." And now the time has come. In the side façade of Barentszstraat 5B, the artwork has been relocated

An additional advantage of this place is that the east and west now actually point to the east or west. It looks fantastic, thanks to all who have worked for this.



The official unveiling will take place later. See the announcement on our website and the information boards in our district. Let this also be a warm welcome for the new residents of this new construction plan within our neighborhood.

Conclusion of project Goede Buren

This beautiful collaboration between the gardeners of Moestuinvereniging de Rijt and the residents of Kerkakkers has been a success for the fourth time this year.

The vegetable gardeners turned out to have surplus vegetables again and they were able to make many local residents happy with that.
