### Maak Rimpels

Do the things you want to do for as long as possible? Maak Rimpels!

If, as a 65+, you want to remain independent and self-reliant for as long as possible, the broad prevention program "Make Wrinkles" is for you. It is offered free of charge by your municipality, in cooperation with health insurance companies and GP organisations. The coffee and tea are also free. Make Wrinkles consists of four parts:

"Positive Health", we meet four times to gain insight into our broad health.

"Digital skills", we discover the smartphone in six sessions, "surf" the internet safely and introduce useful apps to stay independent and active.

"Vitality", we improve our balance, strength and flexibility in two times eight meetings under the guidance of an experienced exercise coach, because moving together is so much more fun. And

**"Co-reliance"**, together we make agreements in four meetings about our co-reliance and learn to stay digitally connected with the group. 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## Work session working group Biodiversity

We would like to invite you to think about how we can make our neighborhood greener and brighter. The brainstorming/work session will take place on 13 March, starting at 8:00 pm in the hall of neighbourhood association De Horizon on the Amundsenstraat 5.

What are we going to do?

In this inspiring work session, we look at the possibilities and major benefits of a green neighbourhood. With an inspiring presentation, we will take you to all kinds of fun, interesting and successful green projects that take place elsewhere in the country. Then we get to work together, brainstorming about green activities that we can and want to realize together in the neighborhood, with or without the help of the municipality. The projects can be very small, from hanging birdhouses, planting a colourful bulb field in the municipal park or the desire for a sedum roof.

Madeleine Velthuizen, local resident and project officer of the biodiversity working group, will lead the inspiration session. Then we ask you to share the ideas for a greener neighborhood with each other and with us. We will include these for the biodiversity work programme for 2024 - 2025. Ad Lavrijssen, Green Manager at the municipality of Valkenswaard will tell you what is happening in the municipality and where there is room for improvement.

With your help, what have we already done in 2023? Last year, the biodiversity working group took several initiatives for a greener neighbourhood. You received seed bags in the spring to brighten up your garden. Flower bulbs in the autumn. The working group also knocked on the door of several local residents to ask if they wanted to adopt a tree mirror or create a façade garden. We have had nice reactions to this: Several tree mirrors and façade gardens have already been realized.

This year, we hope to see even more to come. We look forward to seeing you on **March 13th!**

## Tenants now also receive disconnection subsidy

The homeowners already received a subsidy for disconnecting their downspout. But now tenants are also eligible for this! Rainwater is very valuable. It is clean water that still flows straight into the wastewater sewer and sewage treatment plant for most people. Sin! Because if the clean water can flow into your garden and sink into the soil - or even be stored and stored - then your trees and plants will benefit greatly. Especially in hot, dry summers.



Why?
Detaching your
downspout from the
sewer is called
disconnecting. The
municipality applauds
the fact that more and
more residents are
making their homes
more sustainable by

disconnecting the downspout from the sewer. This sustainable adaptation is not only good for the environment, plants and biodiversity, but it also relieves the sewer system in the streets, so that the risk of flooding is much reduced. Subsidy & free advice? You can receive a contribution of € 5.00 per square metre of roof area. The only condition is that the roof area is at least 40 square meters (length x width). Moreover, the municipality also offers free advice at home on how to go about it. These advisors will visit you without obligation to see what solutions are possible to disconnect the downspouts in front and back gardens. Participate? ### **Energy fixers also in Valkenswaard**

You probably want to save energy in your home. That's good for your wallet and for the environment. Don't know how to start? Then we have good news! In Valkenswaard, many agencies offer help and advice. Often completely free of charge. **Energy fixers** help people with poorly insulated homes or private rented homes to save energy. Together with you, they will look around your house and give free tips. They fix small problems on the spot. For example, by installing LED lamps, draught strips, a letterbox brush or radiator foil. This way, your energy consumption immediately decreases. Do you want an Energy Fixer to come and see you too? If you own a home or private rental home with energy label E, F or G, you will automatically receive an invitation. Tenants of Woningbelang and Woonbedrijf can inquire about the possibilities there. Open every Saturday from 10 am to 12 pm. You can find the Energy Desk in the library at the Hofnar. Feel free to drop by if you want to know how you can make your home more sustainable. Tip: bring an overview of your annual gas and electricity consumption.

#### **Energy allowance: Low income?**

Apply for the energy allowance for 2023 now. The energy allowance is a reimbursement for your energy costs for the year 2023. It is an amount of € 800,-. Many low-income households receive the energy allowance automatically. Have you not received anything but do you have a low income? Then you can apply for the energy allowance yourself.
