Saturday 3 September

Free Neighbourhood Afternoon at Buurtschap Kerkakkers on the Dr. Schaepmanstraat. From **2:30** to ±**5:00** pm. For the children there is an extensive program. For adults there is also a lottery. Would you like to take a look?

Friday 9 September,

is preview evening. In Theater De Hofnar, various professional artists present from **7:30 pm** with a free preview of their new theater program.

Saturday 10 September,

from 12:00 am to 6:00 pm, colourful dahlia objects can once again be viewed in the centre of Valkenswaard. As in 2021, visitors can view the dahlia objects for free on foot or by bike and enjoy local dance, music and theatre companies and street performances. De Markt offers a stage to local dance schools and in Theater De Hofnar you can enjoy theatre and music. On Saturday evening, various musical performances will take place on stage at the Statie from 7:00 pm.

Sunday 11 September is the Corso parade again. From 11.00 am, the parade floats are spread over the course in the center of Valkenswaard. From 12:00 you can already expect extras, fanfares and musical acts. All cars (including the youth!) will ride the parade at the same time at 2:00 pm. As a result, the public immediately sees a car, regardless of the location on the course. After 1 lap, each car stops at the place where it started and you can enjoy the full acts on and around all cars until 4.30 pm. Admission is FREE this year.

In the afternoon you can enjoy various performances at the stage at the Statie and on the Markt of street theater and music. At **7.00 pm** hours the award ceremony is on stage at the Statie and there you can enjoy a musical spectaclel.

Door & Voor 14 September: Evening walk around the Brugven

On Wednesday, September 14, there is another evening walk on the program. We want to leave at **7:00 pm** from the parking lot at the cemetery on the Sil. Right in front of garden center Bannenberg you cross the Maastrichterweg. A hundred meters further on the left is the cemetery. Here we can park bike or car.

We walk via the old railway line to the Brugven, very nicely situated between the greenery. Already in prehistoric times there was human habitation here, as well as on the Malpie. Itinerant tribes almost always settled near water, looking for game, fruits and seeds. Flints have also been found in both places. At the picnic bench we have a short coffee stop. Free coffee, tea and cake are provided. The walk is in total about 3.5 km. Not too far, we have done this especially to give people who have just a little less condition, the chance to walk along. What you need to think about:

- Obviously easy shoes. We sometimes walk on narrow forest paths.
- It is wise to rub yourself against mosquitoes and ticks. Better to prevent than to cure! Dense clothing is of course also fine!

We hope for good weather and a nice turnout! The participation is free, the coffee, tea and cake also. Ankie Slaats and Nelly van der Burgt.



The Kaatse Bossen

The new cycle path from the Kromstraat to the Dommel will be called "De Kaatse Bossen", after the cadastral name of that area. The origin of this name is difficult to explain. Caetse soil could indicate wet soil. Nevertheless, the ground here is located high and easy to drain towards the Dommel.

The oldest local residents, who often use the name, speak of Kètse Bossen. That's more of the original name. That name was probably dutchified by the writer of the land registry around the year 1830 to "De Kaatsche Bosschen". After all, the áá sound hardly occurs in the local dialect!.

Be that as it may, it is good that the name "De Kaatse Bossen", as the name for the cycle path, is kept alive.


